

Instructions for Authors for abstract preparation

1. Font type: Times New Roman

2. The margins: top 1'' bottom 1'' left 1'' right 1''

3. Line Space: 1.5

4. Title

Font type and size: Times New Roman 11

Justified text in bold

Sentence case

Abstract titles should be short, but descriptive. Informative titles, indicating key points is encouraged. Use an initial capital letter only for the first word and for proper nouns. Abbreviations should not be used in the title. Scientific names must be in *Italic*.

5. Authors

Font type and size: Times New Roman 10

Justified text in bold

Surname / family name of the author, initials of other names and no space in between initials.

Name of the corresponding author should be marked with asterisk symbol.

6. Affiliations

Font type and size: Times New Roman 10 and in italic

Affiliations should be indicated with superscript Arabic numbers appearing at the start of Initials of name.

Names of affiliations should be given including the country.

If there is more than one name and address, they should be related by superscript numbers.

E.g.: ¹INITIALS Surname, ²INITIALS Surname

¹Affiliation, Country

²Affiliation, Country

7. Correspondence details

Font type and size: Times New Roman 10

Email address of the corresponding author should be provided.

8. Main text

Font type and size: Times New Roman 11

Main text should be written as one paragraph WITHOUT any subheadings.

9. Keywords

Font type and size: Times New Roman 11

Up to three (03) keywords arranged in the alphabetical order each starting with a capital letter.

10. Word count of abstract

No more than 300 words
